All 1st-6th graders will wear Christmas party attire for ACT I and costumes for ACT II (parents can assist their child with costume changes during intermission). **IMPORTANT:** 1st - 6th graders will need a working flashlight (with their names on it). All PK3-K students will be in ACT I only and may be retrieved by their parents during intermission (not before). All students should report to their classrooms no later than 6:40 p.m. Students will be called to the Fine Arts building by the stage manager at 6:50 p.m. to line up backstage for the show. Costume Requirements

PK3: will be elves. They can be any kind of elf (don't have to be red and green) with rosy cheeks and pointy ears (felt elf ears can be attached directly to the hat). Be creative (i.e. candy cane elf, ballerina elf, football elf, cowboy elf, princess elf).

PK4: will be holiday Trolls. Colorful outfits (like Trolls in movie). Outfits do not have to be green and red. Rosy cheeks. Wigs and headgear are provided.

K: will be in pajamas. No nightgowns, must be a top and pants for the bottom. Make sure the slippers stay on the feet during choreography (slipper socks work well). Need a Santa hat.

1st: will be penguins. Penguin hats are provided. Need orange striped socks. An oversized black T-shirt, turtleneck or sweatshirt with big orange bowtie at neck (shirt must hang mid-thigh) and a large white circle (for tummy) attached to the front of shirt. Gloves will be provided.

2nd: will be country western Mr. and Mrs. Claus. Red or green cowboy hats for girls and boys. Red or green bandannas around neck. Western look for clothes (cowboy boots, jeans, western shirts, jean skirts etc.). Small beards for "Santas" so we can see their faces and white wigs for Mrs. Claus.

3rd: will be 1940's swing dancers. Boys wear a Christmas sweater or vest with a bowtie. Girls wear a flower on side of head and a Christmas tree skirt for their skirt (it is full and circular). Girls can wear anything holiday looking for their top.

4th: will be rock and roll reindeer. Dress in rocker outfits with reindeer antlers (can wear a hat or wig and cut a hole to "pull" antlers through hole). Make sure antlers stay on the head (elastic under the chin).

5th: will be "blues brothers". Dress all in blue (any shade). Pants, shorts, leggings, tights, skirts etc. must be blue. Black sunglasses and a black or blue fedora type hat, black shoes and WHITE socks.

6th: will glow in dark. Everything should be black (including shoes and socks). Wear some type of black cap to tuck hair under. Use neon orange or pink duct tape in your own design over your black outfit (front and back). Masks and props will be provided.
