WISH LIST

Paper plates, plastic forks, plastic spoons
Quick fix foods (individual serving size)
individually wrapped snacks (granola bars, crackers, snack cakes, chips, pretzels, etc.)
Cookies, Juice boxes, Oatmeal (microwaveable packets)

Sugar (bags and pourable canisters) Sweetener Packets (such as Splenda, Sweet & Low, etc.)
Coffee stirrer sticks, Styrofoam coffee cups (12 oz. and 14 oz. sizes), Plastic cups (Solo cups),
Paper bowls

Bath towels (white) ,Bath washcloths (white), Queen fitted sheets (white),

Standard size pillows

Body wash (men & women), Disposable razors, Adult-size toothbrushes
Shower curtains (cloth, colors: white, beige & sage green), Shower liners (plastic/vinyl)
Medium-size plastic garbage cans , Manual can openers, Toilet Paper, Lysol spray
